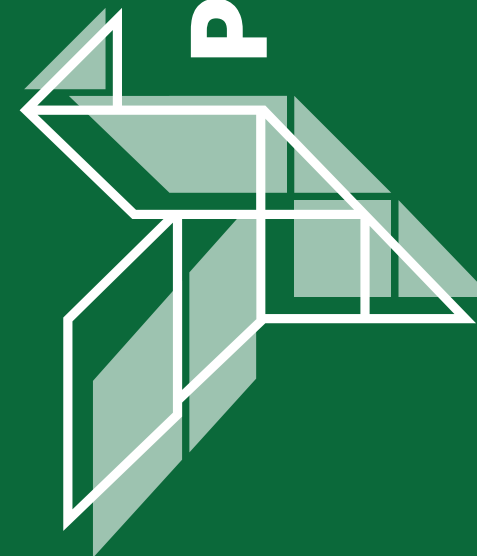

Why now?

Our mission

The **European growth strategy** aimed at ensuring:

- no net emissions of greenhouse gases by 2050
- economic growth decoupled from resource use
- no person and no place left behind

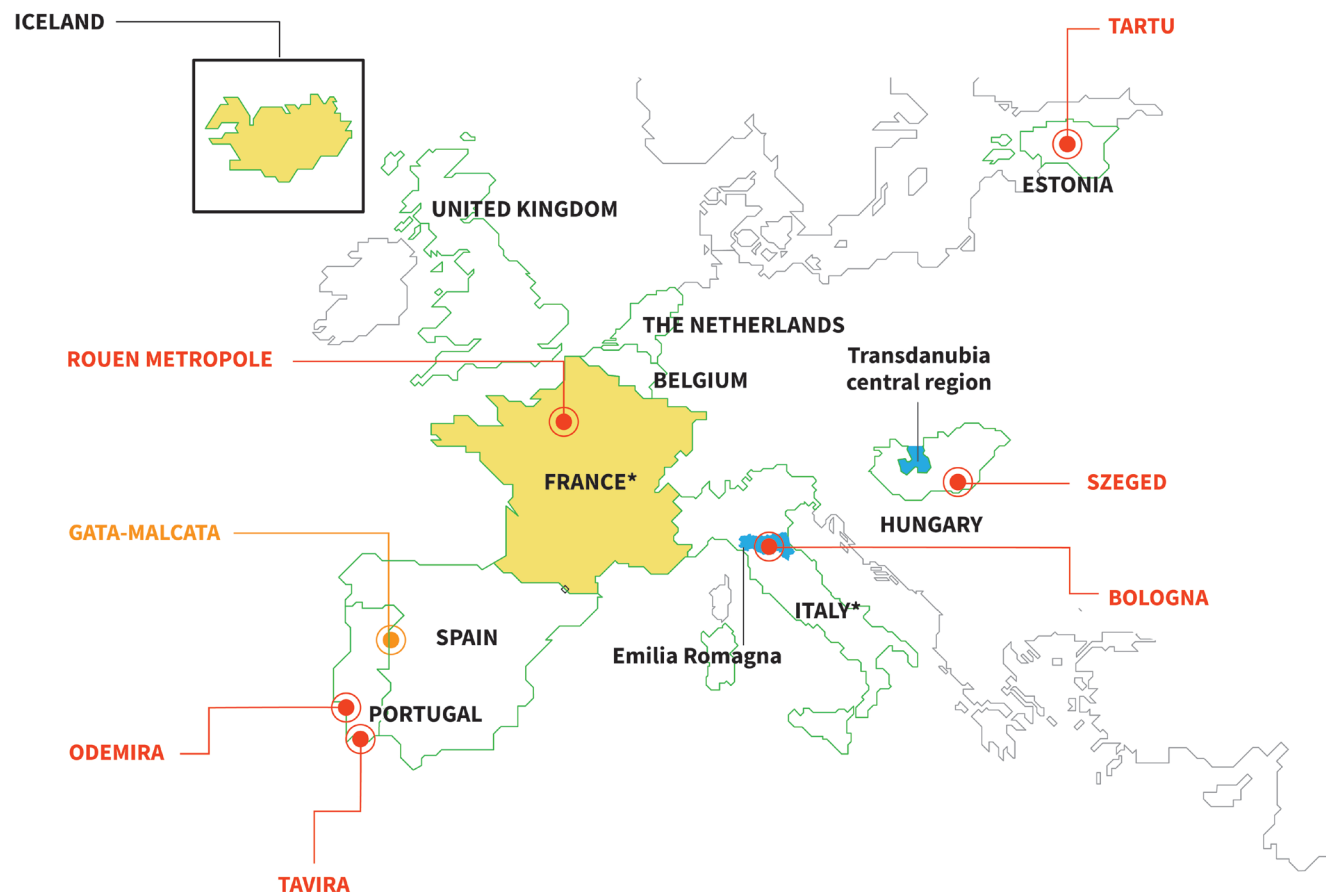
